EARLY LEARNING PLAY GROUP	This is a FREE drop-in style program for all parents and caregivers with children 0 – 6 years of age, to come together and explore, learn, create, and play in our child friendly spaces; talk to professionals in the Early Childhood field; and connect with others.
PLAY DINE & DASH	Drop-in style, this FREE program is offered to all parents and caregivers with children 0 – 6 years of age. During this evening event participants are given the opportunity to explore, learn, and play before a meal is served to them.
LIT'L CHEFS FUN ZONE	Register for this FREE afterschool program. Enjoy creating a special snack with your child, and then take advantage of some free-play time before you head home!
TINY TOTS TOGETHER	This FREE drop-in program is for parents and caregivers with children under the age of 18 month, to connect with each other, share stories, advice and support, while playing with your children in an environment designated for your little one.
LET'S GET MOVING GYM PLAY	Drop in at this FREE play group dedicated to gross motor play. Explore the different activities and equipment that will be set up in the gym space. Talk to a professional about typical child development and resources/supports that can help you and your family.
Family enrichment	Registration is required to participate in this FREE program, that offers parents a break from their children, so they can further their education in parenting and personal life skills. Children are cared by staff and volunteers while parents attend class.
